



TRANSFER STATION - SEASON OPENING

Due to current & predicted weather conditions, the station will not be opening this April unless spring decides to actually appear.

Thursday, May 4; Friday, May 5; & Saturday, May 6

Check fb for updates.

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Thursdays, Fridays & Saturdays; 1:00 pm – 4:30 pm

Wet conditions compromise the road and grounds, effectively CLOSING the station to the public until they are dry enough to reopen. Only Herbert ratepayers are permitted access to the station. Applicable fees will be at the discretion of the Town attendant, recorded and invoiced accordingly through the Town Office. A 30 yd roll-off bin is available for items not allocated to any of the designated areas of the station.

BIN FEES: \$25.00 per half of a ½ ton load | \$50.00 per full ½ ton load

*Cash is not accepted at the station.

ACCEPTED STATION ITEMS:

- Branches, leaves, grass clippings (a compost pile has been made for leaves & grass clippings)
 - Unpainted and unstained wood
 - Metal and whites (large appliances)
 - A \$10 White fee is charged for large appliance drop-off.
- *The Town will issue invoices for any fee amounts owed.

NOT ACCEPTED BIN ITEMS:

- Household Garbage
- Tires/Oil/Oil Filters
- Large amounts of any construction materials such as gyproc, shingles, etc.
- Hazardous Household Waste: Adhesives, automotive, batteries, cleaners, corrosives, fuels, mercury, oxidizers, poisons, pharmaceuticals, propane cylinders, ammunition or solvents, etc.

*Concrete or asphalt pavement are not accepted.
