
The SUMMER REC Program will be postponed from August 6th – 8<sup>th</sup> and will resume the week of August 13<sup>th</sup> -15<sup>th</sup>.



It's difficult to address all of the properties that do not comply with Nuisance Bylaw 2015-04 without immediately resorting to the lengthy Order to Remedy (OTR) process.

However, to kick start & remind residents of their obligation to maintain their yards, the Town will hand deliver a <u>NOTICE</u> regarding nuisance issues such as grass overgrowth, weeds, &/or tree care.

If the property is still neglected after the allotted seven (7) day time frame Town Maintenance can be directed to mow a property resulting in a \$250 charge, for a 50' x 120' lot, which will then be added to the property owners' tax roll.



#### ADVERTISING OPPORTUNITY

It is the property owners' responsibility to keep the sidewalks clear of overgrowth from hedges & shrubbery, etc. Pedestrians are being forced off of the sidewalk into the boulevard or street.

Aside from sidewalks, overgrown bushes are cause for traffic hazards by blocking visibility at corners.

Overgrown tree branches are also impeding back lane vehicle traffic & should also be pruned back to the property line, with the exception of elm trees.

Elms cannot be trimmed or cut from April 1 -August 31 to prevent the spread of Dutch Elm disease.
